**WORLD DAY OF THE SICK  
FEBRUARY 11<sup>TH</sup>**

The 23<sup>rd</sup> World Day of the Sick will be celebrated on February 11<sup>th</sup> – the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. In anticipation of the celebration, the Holy Father reminds us all: “Even when illness, loneliness and inability make it hard for us to reach out to others, the experience of suffering can become a privileged means of transmitting grace and a source for gaining and growing in sapientia cordis [wisdom of the heart]” (Pope Francis, Message for the 23<sup>rd</sup> World Day of the Sick).
