REFUGEE SPONSORSHIP

Thanks to Kevin Herman's efforts, Karen Mahoney from the Catholic Immigration Center was on hand at the Sunday Social to provide information on sponsoring a Catholic refugee family and to answer people's questions. She clarified that the sponsoring group, in this case our parish, agrees to provide the refugees with care, lodging, settlement assistance and support for 12 months starting from the refugee's arrival in Canada. Private sponsors normally support the sponsored refugees by:

- o providing the cost of food, rent and household utilities and other day-to-day living expenses;
- o providing clothing, furniture and other household goods;
- o assisting with applying for available health-care coverage;
- o enrolling children in school and adults in language training;
- o providing orientation with regard to banking services, transportation, etc.

Generally a family of four would cost the sponsoring parish about \$30,000 for the 12 month obligation period; however, this is a rough estimate and the circumstances and needs of each family are unique. If this project does go ahead, please consider contributing a little more.

Fr. Vincent indicated that he would like to sponsor a Catholic Malkite family. Kevin Herman will be forming a committee to move this project forward and would welcome all those interested in joining, or otherwise volunteering, to contact him at kevin.herman81@outlook.com.
