Supporting women and girls is a priority for Development and Peace (D&P). When 276 girls were kidnapped by Boko Haram in Nigeria, the local D&P partner began working for their freedom, and has managed to smuggle three girls to safety. D&P's Share Lent collection is on the Fifth Sunday of Lent, March 22<sup>nd</sup>.
