COMMUNITY EVENTS & INTERESTS

ARCHDIOCESE OF OTTAWA-CORNWALL

The Archdiocese of Ottawa and the Diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall are in the process of amalgamating: On April 27, 2018, the Holy Father, Pope Francis, united, *in persona episcopi*, the Diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall with the Archdiocese of Ottawa, and appointed Archbishop Prendergast as archbishop of Ottawa and bishop of Alexandria-Cornwall. On December 12, 2018, the Holy Father appointed as auxiliary bishop of the diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall, the Rev. Fr. Guy Desrochers, C.Ss.R. In consultation with both Dioceses, the decision was made that the new unified diocese will be known as the Archdiocese of Ottawa-Cornwall. The process of amalgamation under canon and civil law is both lengthy and complex. We aim to periodically report our progress and the key decisions that have been reached.
